

16. The representative/s of the Department shall have access to the supplier's premises and shall have the power at all reasonable time to inspect and examine materials .

17. If the successful tenderer/s fails to supply the goods of the prescribed specifications or fails to deliver the goods within the 10 days time period which shall be specifically mentioned in the supply order, the department shall be at liberty to arrange supplies from other alternate sources at the risk and cost of tenderer/s.

18. All legal proceedings arising out of any dispute between the parties shall have to be instituted in the Courts J&K state at Jammu or Srinagar and not elsewhere. In case of any dispute, the decision of the Administrative Department (Home Department) / Director General of Police, J&K shall be final and binding upon both parties.

19. The successful tenderer/s shall arrange supplies within the period mentioned in the supply order. The period of delivery and validity can however be extended if mutually agreed to.

20. The contract / supply order can be cancelled any time if the supplies are not made according to satisfaction of the Department.

21. The stores supplied should be strictly in-accordance with approved samples which can be seen by the intending tenderer/s in the Central Stores Jammu and also as per specifications mentioned in the supply order.

22. The supplier shall not sublet the contract or any part thereof to any other agency.

23. The tender/s should sign on each page of the tender at the end in token of having agreed to the terms and conditions of the NIT.

24. The decision of the accepting authority shall be final and binding on the suppliers . In case the articles are rejected, the loss caused due to rejection / replacement of the supplies shall be entirely borne by the supplier. The rejected articles shall be lifted by the supplier within one week from the date of information of the rejection. The department shall in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur to the rejected stores while these are in the premises of the department
